We're excited to share that our evaluation partner, Prosono, is launching an **Ecosystem Data Map project**. This project is a collaborative effort to better understand how our programs are making an impact on Denver students and to support your organizations more effectively.

Why This Matters

To ensure our data collection practices are meaningful and manageable, we're starting to look at the current data reporting landscape. This will help us:

- 1. **Collect Right-size data** to fit the current capacity and practices of our diverse Supported Organizations.
- 2. **Map the data points** your organizations are already gathering, so we can assess PDF's requirements, ensure compliance with city ordinance requirements, and identify any areas for support.
- 3. **Create common language** around key indicators and data points to strengthen collaboration.

What We're Asking from You

We're asking each supported organization share your **most robust data reporting templates** that you use with any of your funders.

We don't need your raw data or individual responses—just the tools and templates (like PDFs, Excel sheets, survey screenshots, etc.) that show what information your funders require.

Examples include:

- Reporting forms
- Website screenshots of reporting systems
- Survey or intake tools
- Excel templates for funder reporting

This will help us understand the types of data being requested and develop a more unified approach to data collection across the ecosystem.

How We'll Use This Information

- All responses will be aggregated for shared learning, not individual evaluations.
- We'll use AI tools to support analysis while following strong data privacy and protection standards.

• The findings will inform PDF's data requirements and help us explore ways to support **capacity building**.

Timeline

- April 25: We announced the Ecosystem Data Map project at our in-person SO Learning Community
- June 27: Official launch and overview during our virtual meeting
- June 27-August 1: Open collection period for data templates
- August 22: Sessions for sense-making and feedback
