To be in good standing, you must complete a degree or certificate prior to attempting 150% of the credits needed for the program. Letter grades of A through D-, P (passing) and IP grades contribute positively to a student's completion rate. Letter grades of F, W, I and NW contribute negatively to a student's completion rate. Repeated courses and credits transferred to the university both count towards a student's completion rate. If you take a course and receive a grade higher than an "F", you may receive financial aid to retake the course one time. If you take a passed course a third time, the course will not count towards your enrollment for financial aid. Undergraduates must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of a 2.0. First year Masters of Physician Assistant Studies students must maintain a cumulative GPA of a 2.8. Second and third year students must maintain at least a passing cumulative grade. Dental students must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of between 2.3 and 3.0, depending on their program. Pharmacy students must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of a 2.0.
